

TUMC ASP Picture Policy

- I. Picture Upload Policy
 - a. The Timonium United Methodist Church Appalachia Service Project (TUMC ASP) requires that volunteers upload a profile picture of themselves to the TUMC ASP's website (tumcasp.com). It is the responsibility of the volunteer uploading the picture to ensure that the picture is of them, is appropriate (to the discretion of a TUMC ASP admin), is legal, and is not copyrighted by somebody else. It is recommended that the profile picture be taken by the volunteer themselves. A volunteer holds all responsibility to picture that is uploaded, and will be held responsible for any issues that should arise from the image, including, but not limited to any legal action that may occur. TUMC ASP reserves the right to edit, modify, change, duplicate, reuse and/or remove a volunteer uploaded photo at any time without notification, for any reason, and the volunteer still holds all responsibility for the original picture.
- II. Pictures of Volunteers and supporters
 - a. In participating in any TUMC ASP activity, including, but not limited to any meetings and fundraisers, TUMC ASP accepts the right to take, store, modify, and use any image in any form, including use on the TUMC ASP website (tumcasp.com) taken of any volunteer or supporter. Volunteers and supporters may request to the photographer for them not to be included in a photo. It is up to the photographer whether or not to include the volunteer or supporter in the photo.
